Junior Maths Challenge Success 2019

Pupils at Junior King's achieved 6 golds, 13 silvers and 23 bronzes in this year's UKMT Junior Maths Challenge. Over 270,000 pupils from across the UK sat the Junior Maths Challenge with roughly 6% receiving a gold certificate; the next 13%, silver; and the next 21%, bronze. Approximately 9200 (3.4%) of the top students are invited to sit a follow-on competition, The Junior Mathematical Olympiad or Kangaroo. Joseph W qualified for the Junior Mathematical Olympiad (putting him in the top 1200 or 0.4% of students in the UK) and Yolanda, Sean and Tolu qualified for the Kangaroo (putting them in the top 9200 or 3.4% of students in the UK).

"The maths challenges provide material to provoke students' mathematical thinking and test their problem solving skills in an accessible and yet challenging way. Many congratulations to Junior King's School Canterbury on their success in the Junior Maths Challenge; it is great to see achievement in mathematics recognised." 




Le Spectacle


